Services are provided by IRS-trained volunteers who work with clients to identify tax credits, such as the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) and Child Tax Credit (CTC) that often go unclaimed, while helping them avoid the added cost of paid preparers and predatory lending to advance returns.
